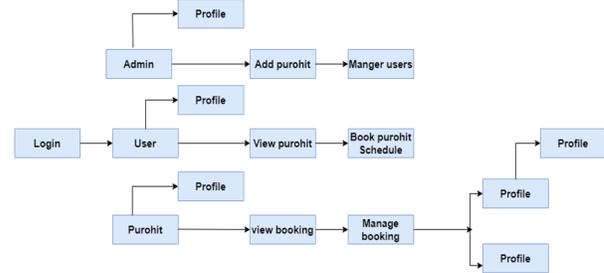


Fig 1: system architecture

data and analyzing it using organized tools is a necessary step as shown in figure 1.

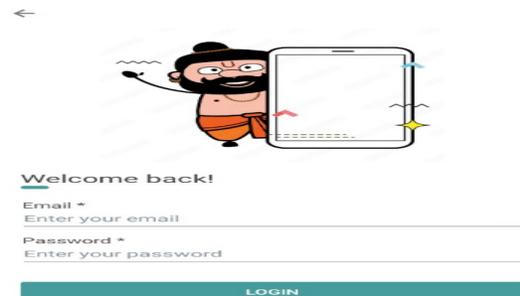


Fig 4: Screen Shot of Login Page

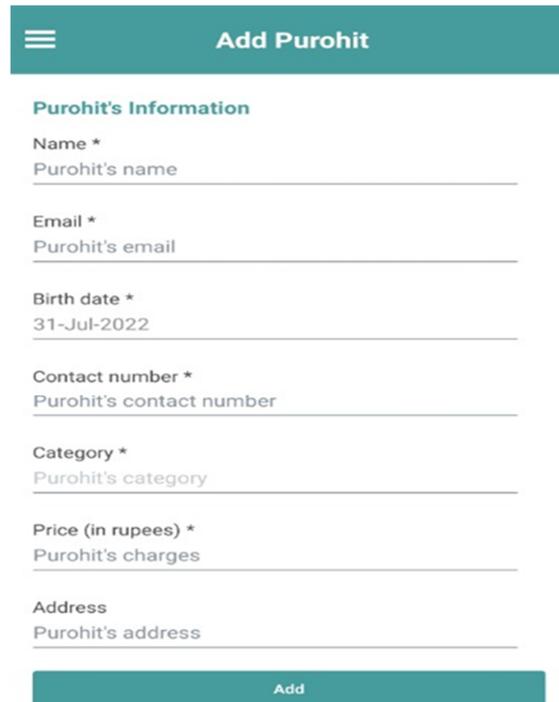


Fig 5: Screen Shot of Add new purohit (admin)

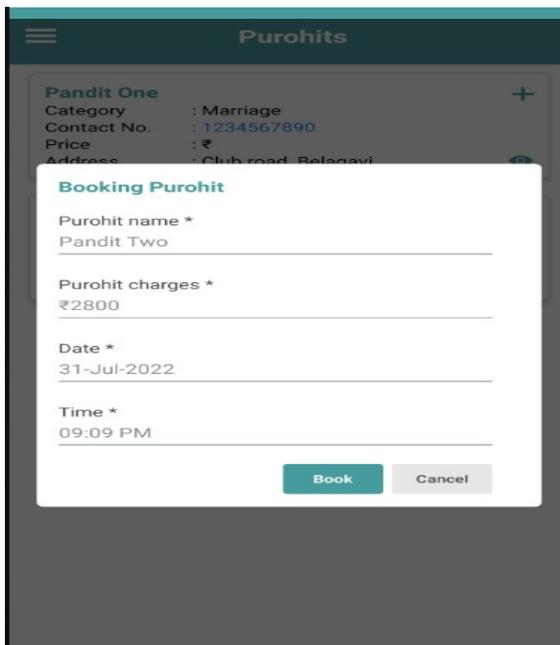


Fig 10: Screen Shot of Booking Purohits (Normal user)
